In spite of all our knowledge and wonderful technology the human race is now in a dangerously unbalanced situation perpetuated by corporate empires driving human expansion in the wrong direction. Putting profit before people and nature is the single most direct cause of all the disastrous human and environmental problems the whole world now faces. At the root of these problems is the spiritual void inherent in the ideological building blocks of the Materialist Construct of Daniel's Great Image. We are the generations with the responsibility and option to choose the path with a future for our children.
