BREAKTHROUGH TO ENLIGHTENMENT

We are all living in tomorrow's past.

What we think and do today will shape our tomorrow.

This is as true for us as a species as it is true for us as individuals. When a carpenter or electrician or plumber comes to fix a problem they come with the right tool kit to do the job. What tool kit do we have to fix our problems: individually and collectively?

The answer itself was a big indication of the real root of all our problems: The delusion of materialism and all its consequential wrong priorities.

Throughout history the minority that have held the reins of great power and wealth have accumulated their vast fortunes and grown their empires at the expense of the poorer majority. Globally wrong priorities led from the top, have created huge social and environmental problems that now affect everyone on our planet. In spite of our increased knowledge today we are faced with the consequences of decades of greed led from the top: corruption in governments, inequality; poverty, social unrest and wars.

When men driven by materialism look at the Earth they don't see something to be cherished, instead they see a means of making money. And so they set about exploiting its resources: digging it up; felling forests and killing other creatures that get on their way. All this leaves a trail of ruin, barrenness, pollution and death in the wake of what only a fool would call progress.

In reality such "progress" is destroying our planet's life support systems and will ultimately destroy us. This is both needless and completely stupid. On a recent Radio 4 program an entomologist likened our planet to a hundred weight sack of rice; which contains over 2 million grains of rice. If we take one grain of rice out of that sack - that one grain of rice would represent the entire human species! The rest of the 2 million grains are the other species on Earth. On this planet we humans are a minority species! But sadly we are also the one single species doing the most damage to this world and the only species which needs to drastically change its ways. Historically human civilisation has been led by wrong priorities from the top down. Consequently we are divided from each other, divided from nature and divided from our Creator.

The basic source of all our problems is wrong priorities derived from a materialist view of life. Of course, we all do wrong things at times but the fact is: those with the most wealth and power: global organisations and corporations; have a far greater capacity to detrimentally affect the world than any single individual. Even when great power and wealth has been obtained some continue to exploit people and nature to gain more. In spite of various social benefits used to excuse such actions this is what has happened throughout history. Concentration on material wealth and power has caused destruction of the environment, inequality, poverty and war. All these things cause trauma: feelings of powerlessness and hopelessness. This is not a good way to live. But it needn't be that way.

A LARGER PERSPECTIVE

Life is designed to thrive. All around us in nature there is an organic symmetry, interconnectedness and purpose. Why would that be? The reason is that everything which exists comes from One Source and all share the same One Spirit of Life. This is reflected at all levels of existence: spiritually, energetically and materially, right down to the quantum level.

Grandfather David Monongeye, of the Hopi People, said:

"We are all flowers in the Great Spirit's Garden. We all share a common root, and the root is Mother Earth."

Oren Lyons, Faith- keeper of the Onondaga Nation once said: "We are quests on this Earth, not its masters"

Jamie Samms of the Choctaw and Iroquois put it like this:

Human beings tend to forget that no man-made organization is the Source – the only real Source is the Great Mystery – our Creator"

Paul's Letter to the Romans (18:25) highlights the root of our problems: "They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served artificial things rather than the Creator."

The human world is in such a mess today because we have forgotten our Creator, and thereby forgotten our connection to Creation and to each other. Somewhere along the road of human "progress" we have lost our sense of place: lost our way – lost our spiritual connection to each other and to the world we inhabit. Indigenous Peoples of America have spoken of our need to recognise both our Creator and the Creation we are part of. Unfortunately the other Nations of the modern world - enchanted by their own cleverness chose to ignore them. This is proving to be a fatal mistake.

Yeshua, who we now call Jesus, highlighted the only two priorities we need to rebalance ourselves and save our world.

First: Love and respect for our Creator; Second: Love and respect for our fellow beings.

We all know love works in everyday relationships but to make it work globally we need a quantum shift in the priorities of those at the top.
